HITTING CLINIC TO BE HELD

Macomb, IL, April 13, 2011

We are thrilled to announce that Crystl Bujtos has agreed to host an hour long hitting clinic for boys and girls ages 6 to 14 at Macomb High School April 13th at 3:00 pm. Crystl is a two time Olympic gold medalist and holds the world record of six home runs during an Olympic series.

Additional highlights include:

- 2008 Softball Player of the Year
- Silver Medalist at the Beijing Games hitting .500 (11-for-22) with a team-high six home runs and 10 RBI. She also broke two of her own records as well as tied one.
- She broke the record of most home runs hit (5) in an Olympic Games with six and broke her Olympic slugging percentage of .923 from 2004 hitting 1.318 in 2008.
- She recorded 12 runs as the U.S. outscored opponents 58-5, while tying her own RBI Olympic record with 10 from 2004.
- World Cup Champion (2006 & 2007)
- Three-time Pan American gold medalist (1999, 2003 & 2007)
- World Champion (2006)
- Two-time Olympic Gold medalist (2000 & 2004)

Venus Taylor, former Western Illinois University softball standout will be assisting Crystl along with former head softball coach, Kathy Veroni.

The clinic is held in conjunction with the second annual "Emma Bozarth" THINK ZEBRA benefit softball game to raise awareness and fundraise for the Immune Deficiency Foundation. The game, MACOMB vs ILLINI WEST is scheduled for April 13th and is a perfect fit since Emma is a player on the Macomb High School softball team and she herself has a life threatening, immunodeficiency disease.

The cost of the clinic is \$5 and payable at the door. Various supports, merchants and businesses in both communities have commemorative Olympic medals to award to any youth interested in attending the hitting clinic. If you come with this medal the clinic is free and the medal is yours to keep! All equipment will be provided but feel free to bring your own if you would like!
